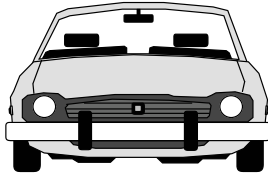

SafeOregon

All schools in the David Douglas School District are now connected with SafeOregon, including David Douglas High School.

SafeOregon is a program created for Oregon students, parents, school staff, community members and law enforcement officers to report and respond to bullying, racism, discrimination, harassment, violence, threats and drug concerns. District administrators have been trained in how to use it, and a trusted staff member from each school has been selected to receive tips concerning their schools that were provided via SafeOregon. Summer Driver Education

Students must have a driver's permit before signing up for Driver Ed.

Applications will be available in the North Office.

The session runs June 13th through July 23rd, 2018.

\$125.00 Free and Reduced Lunch students aged 15 – 17* (in-district students only). Must bring letter of qualification for Free/Reduce Lunch when you sign up.

\$200.00 Students aged 15 – 17*, either in or out of district, with instructional permit.

\$400.00 Students licensed and/or 18 years old before class ends.

\$25.00 Retest fee for 3rd safety test (first two attempts included in session fee).
