

David Douglas High School Athletic Academic Requirements

David Douglas High School is moving toward a quarter system for the school year 2020-2021 which is going to change some athletic eligibility requirements for our students.

1. Student Athletes will need to be enrolled in 3 out of 4 classes each quarter to be a full time student.
2. Student Athletes will need to pass 3 out of 4 classes each quarter otherwise the athlete will be ineligible to compete until the end of the next quarter. If a student athlete does not pass 3 out of 4, their eligibility will be lost until they can get back on track in terms of earning at least 5 credits by the end of the academic year.
3. Athletes still need to be on track to graduate based on a 24 credit system. See the table below.

If they fall below these yearly requirements, an athlete would be ineligible for a complete academic year.

4. Statement From OSAA regarding eligibility based on second semester transcript of 2019-2020 year.

In alignment with ODE's Safeguarding Student Opportunity Clause, the OSAA Executive Board has amended the academic waiver process for the 2020-21 school year. Schools will be able to use transcribed grades from the grading period prior to the COVID-19 showdown to determine eligibility for students that are academically ineligible based on incompletes from the final grading period of 2019-20. These students will not be denied access to school sports and activities provided that the student was eligible entering the final grading period of 2019-20, the school has a Credit-Earning Assurance Plan in place for that student and the student maintains eligibility in the current grading period based on progress reports.

Student Athletes would have also needed to be on track to graduate based on the 25 credit chart above entering the 2019-2020 school year.
